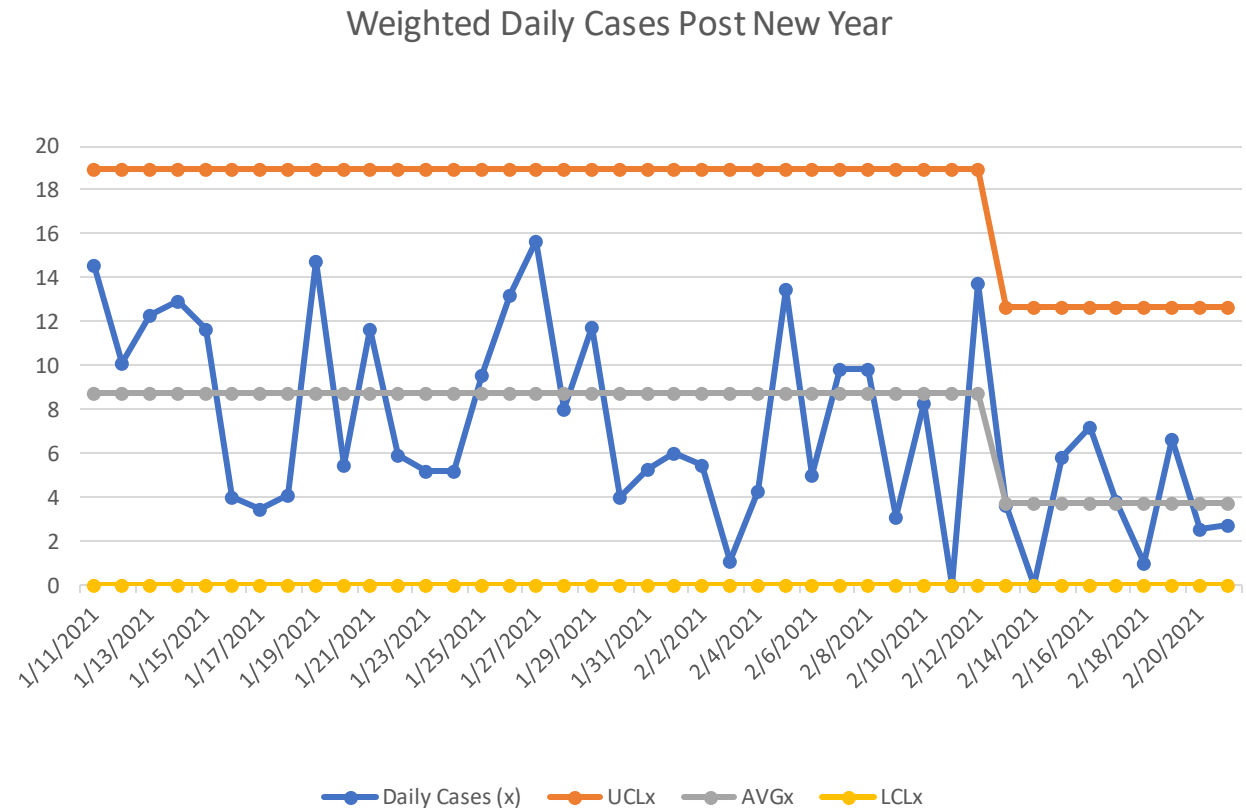

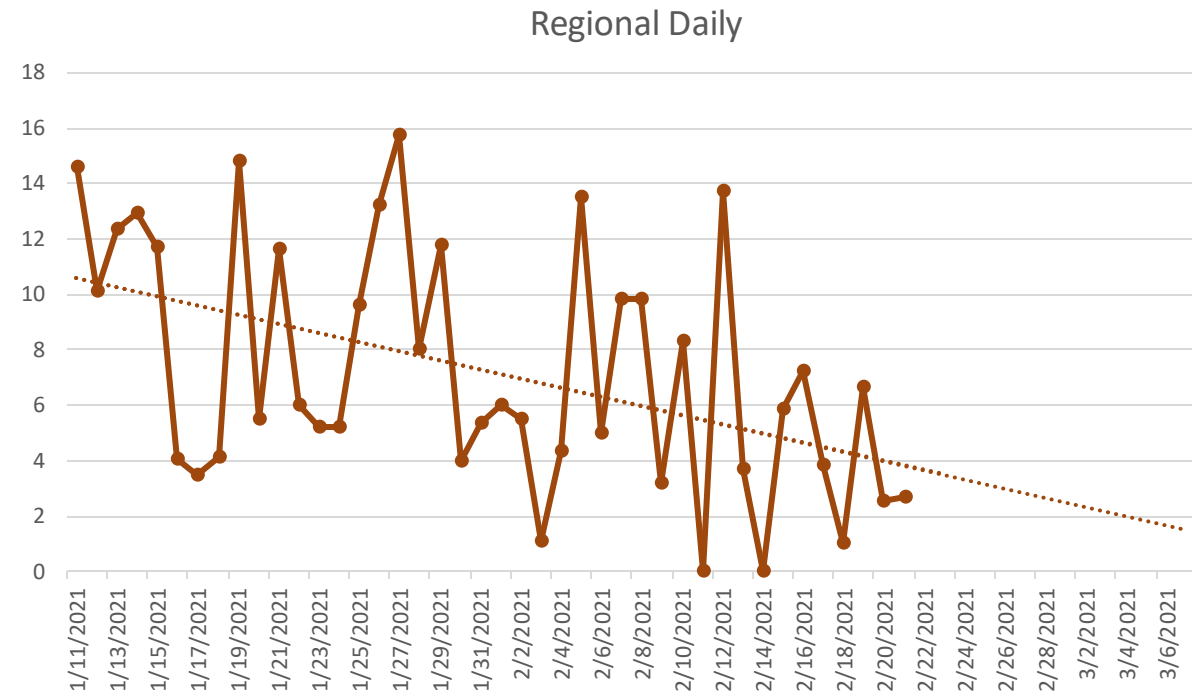
Daily Cases Reported in the Region

- There were seven consecutive days in which the regional daily reported cases were below average. This is like flipping a coin and getting six “heads” in a row. Something is happening that cannot be associated with randomness.
- The average number of reported daily cases dropped from 8.75 cases to 3.73 cases.
- The average number of daily cases reported is approximately the same as the mid-October number



Simple Forecast

- There is a steady downward trend.
- Projections for this two-week period are consistent with the past projections.
- We are returning to “moderate” level of community transmission.

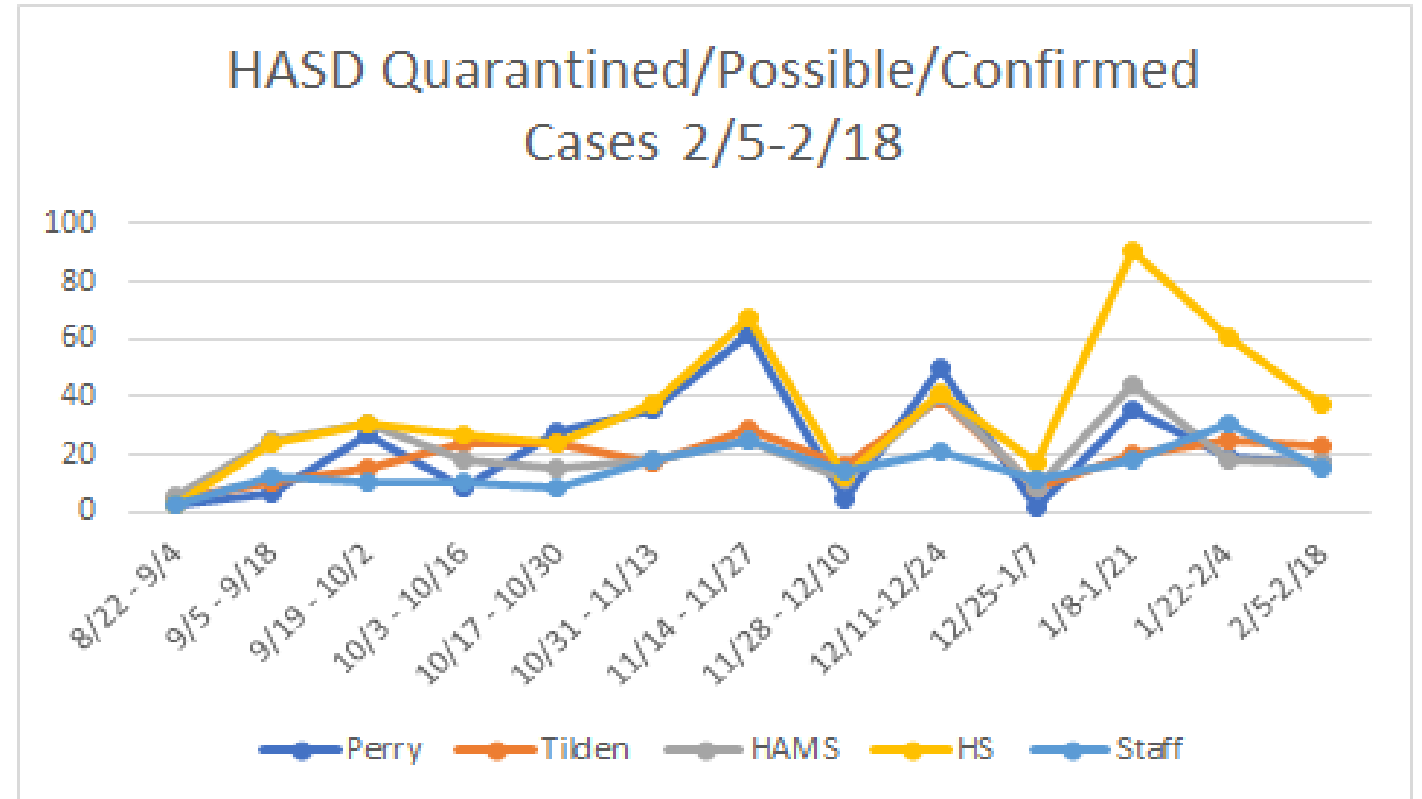

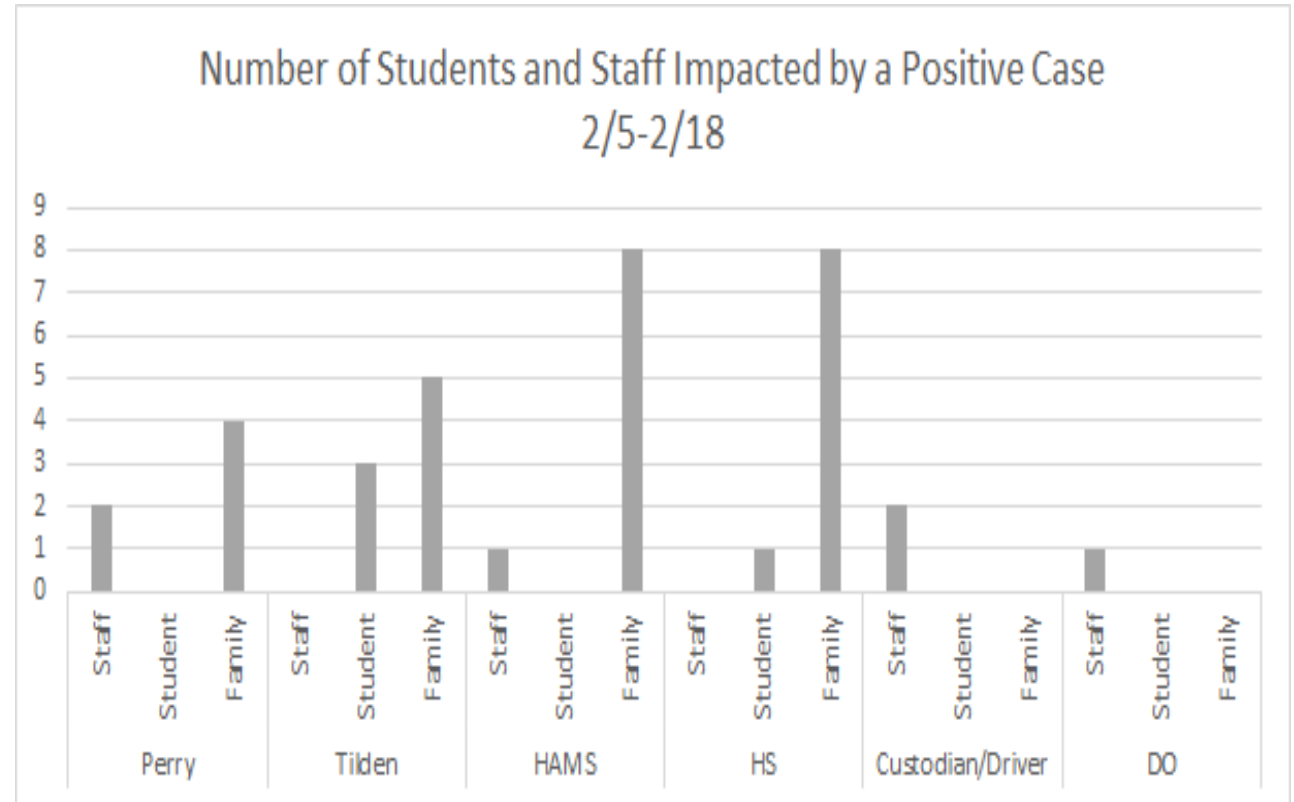
Contact Tracing

- Downward Trend in all categories
- 110 cases tracked over the most recent 14-day period. This is a decrease of 44 cases from the previous period.
- 6 positive cases were reported for staff and students throughout the district. This is a decrease of 13 cases from the previous period.
- Tilden cases traced are increasing due to families reporting symptoms or positive cases within the home.



Positive Cases Breakdown

- Department of Health guidance to reduce live learning
 - ≥ 2 cases **within the building** for buildings with less than 500 people (Perry)
 - ≥ 4 cases **within the building** for buildings with greater than 500 people (Tilden, Middle School, High School)
 - Option for DOH request for consultation
- Known Positive Cases in the School since February 5
 - Perry Elementary – 6
 - 2 staff / 4 family-Virtual
 - DOH Consultation
 - Tilden Elementary – 8
 - 5 family
 - +'s outside the 48 hour infectious period
 - Middle School – 9
 - 8 family
 - High School – 9
 - 8 family



KEY CDC mitigation strategies

- 5 key mitigation strategies: PLUS 1
- **Do not come to work/school if sick or close contact with a positive case.**
 - Consistent and correct use of masks
 - Social distancing to the largest extent possible
 - Hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette
 - Cleaning and disinfection
 - Contact tracing in collaboration with local health department – The graph demonstrates the detailed ability of HASD to track current C19 situations
