

## PENNSYLVANIA HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENT<sup>1</sup>



Students in the graduating class of 2023 and beyond are required to fulfill district graduation requirements as well as select from the following statewide graduation requirements:

OPTION 1 (Keystones)	Score proficient or advanced on each Keystone Exam		
OR			
OPTION 2 (Composite)	□ Earn composite score of 4452 or higher on the Keystone Exams while scoring at least Proficient on one exam and no less than Basic on the other two		

	A 1:1 swap for a non-passed Keystone. Must pass course (Algebra 1, Biology, and/or English 10) AND		
OPTION 3	One alternative assessment:	Acceptance letter at 4-year institution	
(Alternative Assessment)	□ PSAT 970 □ ACT 21	Completion of registered pre- apprenticeship

OPTION 4 (Evidence)	AND

	ACT WorkKeys-Silver*
	□ AP score 3+ in any subject*
	□ Acceptance letter to higher ed institution*
	Industry-recognized credential*
	Pass any dual enrollment course*
	Completion of service-learning project
	Proficient on a Keystone Exam
	Letter of full-time employment after graduation
	□ Successful completion of internship (professional field experience)

OR

	Must pass course (Algebra 1, Biology, and/or English 10)
<b>OPTION 5</b>	AND
(CTE)	Attain Industry-based certification (NIMS/NOCTI) or passing grade at CTE.
