



- 1 application for each individual college
- App fee or fee waiver?

Common Application- Apply Online

- 1 application for multiple colleges
- Long & involved application that includes an essay, sometimes short answer responses.
- App fee or fee waiver?
- Student must manage all required documents.
 - Add Recommender(s)



- o Add HS Counselor
 - Transcript will be sent by Counselor through Common App (so no Parchment needed)

The Essay:

Also known as: the **Personal Statement**.

- Make it count! Might be the only item a college receives about you, beyond grades and test scores.
- Draft, edit, review, and upload to your application. Should take time, not to be rushed.
- Write about something personal, meaningful, memorable.

The SAT/ACT tests



Counselors recommend that all college-bound students take the SAT or ACT



Some specific majors may still require an SAT/ACT such as Nursing, Engineering, Premed, and the Military Academies



Each college uses SAT/ACT in test-optional world, differently. Scholarship consideration, admission, or no impact

After you START the application, request an official transcript through Parchment.





Send Documents:

Transcript:

- Hamburg uses **PARCHMENT** to electronically send transcripts to colleges.
- Please <u>do NOT</u> email your counselor to send a transcript.
- DO set an appointment with counselor if you have questions about the application process.

Exception

If applying using <u>Common App,</u>
Counselor will send transcript through the
Common App account.

- Visit Counseling Office Webpage
- Transcripts & Recommendation TAB
- Watch Tutorial Video to Request a Transcript
- Click on <u>REQUEST MY TRANSCRIPT link</u>
- Create a Parchment account and SEND
 - o \$1.00 for each request

Know deadlines!

- Merit scholarship deadlines are early.
- Early Decision/Early Action includes a completed FAFSA
- RACC/Dual Enrollment and/or AP Exams
 (student must send official transcripts FROM RACC or scores from
 Collegeboard to your college)

Recommendation Letters:

• Know the requirements:

- Which teachers are required
- How many, if any
- Who knows you the best

• Request:

- Make an in-person request
- o Follow up with an email
- Complete Rec Request Form(s)
 - > Teacher Recommendation Reg.
 - > Counselor Recommendation Reg.

• Know how to send:

- Student should know how to send the Recommendation once complete.
- Should writer upload to Common App, electronic link, email Admissions Office, etc?

Application Fee:

Application not complete without paying for Fee or Fee Waiver

- Each school has their own set fee to apply (\$35, \$65...)
- Even if using Common Application, student will still have to submit payment for each college.

• Fee Waivers:

1. For financial need- free or reduced lunches or documented hardship

- Or -


- 2. College offers fee waivers for:
 - Visiting the college/tour
 - Apply by certain date
 - Offers Fee Waiver CODE

Ask Admission! It doesn't hurt to see if they have a waiver available.

Other:

What else is required for application/specific major?

- Physical Therapy
 - Requires observation hours for the application
- Music Major
 - Might require an audition
- Test Optional Alternative
 - Some schools have an "alternative" requirement if student chooses Test Optional.
 - This could be a written. explanation of why they chose test-optional.

State Grant Program







- When student applies to a college, many times they are screened for scholarships.
- Some colleges have a separate scholarships application.



- Check HS Counseling Office Webpage.
- Esther Ludwig application: Strict deadline in early Jan, tbd.

- Use National Search engines for Scholarship search

The Esther Ludwig Scholarship

- Open to all Hamburg residents who attend a 2 year or 4 year college full-time.
- 2 year college requires 80% Unweighted GPA or higher
- 4 year college requires 85% Unweighted GPA or higher
- Application opens November 2023 with a Jan 2024 strict deadline!
- Students will receive manilla envelope with instructions. Applications are managed by an outside agency.



- Dozens of scholarship opportunities for Berks County students
- Various criteria for each scholarship
 - → Students should review criteria to apply to relevant scholarships
- March 1st deadline!
